## TUESDAYS IN THE PLAZA – CONCERT RULES

The following is provided to ensure everyone’s safety and enjoyment at our Tuesday in the Plaza summer concerts:

### Concert Rules:

- All attendees must follow all orders, rules, codes, ordinances, and guidelines of the City of Healdsburg.
- The City of Healdsburg prohibits smoking in public recreation areas and all public spaces within 20’ of a public recreation area. This includes Tuesdays in the Plaza permitted event spaces (i.e., Plaza Park and perimeter sidewalks, closed streets, and all public spaces within 20’ of these spaces).
- Alcohol consumption is permitted in Plaza Park; however, is not permitted in adjoining sidewalks, parking areas, or streets.
- Tents, canopies, and shade structures are not permitted (approved sponsor areas are exempt).
- No person shall sell, vend, peddle, expose, offer for sale, or distribute after sale to the public any merchandise.
- Group seating must be compact as possible; seating and equipment are not allowed in the sidewalk areas. Rope, tape, etc. may not be used to reserve space.
- Tables, blankets, and reserved group seating are not permitted on the concrete.
- Tables must not obstruct the view of other concert attendees.
- No Pets: Pets are prohibited in the Healdsburg Plaza or within 20’ of any temporary food booth/truck/facility between 5:00-8:00 p.m.

Note: Service Animals defined by Title II and Title III of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) are permitted. A service animal means any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, including a physical, sensory, psychiatric, intellectual, or other mental disability. Emotional support animals, comfort animals, and therapy dogs are not service animals under Title II and Title III of the ADA.

- Scooters, skateboards, and bicycles may not be ridden in the event areas.
- Discard any refuse into the proper Recology waste receptacles.
- Barbecue and open flames are prohibited.
- No amplified sound or devices that will disrupt anyone’s enjoyment of the concert.
- Enjoy the music, meet new people, dance, and have fun!
