Matt, See below;

1) Their current permit (issued at the start of the pandemic) is expiring Dec 31st and had loose aesthetic requirements due to the rush to help businesses stay afloat at a time when there were no indoor operations for restaurants/tasting rooms.

**Yes, I clearly understand that - along with everyone else on earth that WAS the reason - to state this is insulting and unnecessary.**

My intention was not to insult but to help explain why parklets have a varying level of aesthetic requirements. Two parklet programs are running simultaneously until the end of this month, and an ongoing program is in development, so it can get confusing. I am glad you understand.

2) Both businesses have applied for a temporary extension, and we are verifying their compliance under stricter guidelines as approved by City Council.

**Please send me those stricter guidelines. WHO is enforcing these new guidelines - what is are the specific name(s) of these enforcers?**

The current guidelines can be downloaded from our [website](#), where you can find information on enforcement, inspections, and violations.

3) Businesses are not required to keep tables/chairs in their parklets when not operating, and many secure them indoors.

**These two businesses have never ever had a table, a chair, or even a customer in the roped off area. It has never ever been used. Both businesses are operated only during the day so this is very easy to monitor. Again if they are not going to use the space you are taking away PUBLIC space that the rest of us PAY for.**

I appreciate your observations and opinion. Thank you.

4) While there is no specific requirement for providing a measurable level of use under the temporary programs, this requirement will be worked into any ongoing parklet program that would outlive the pandemic / temporary parklet programs.

**What? Either there is or there is not. Are you saying there was NOT a "measurable level of use" prior but now there will be? Please point to me where that is spelled out in the new guidelines approved by the City Council.**

Under our current parklet guidelines, there is no specific requirement regarding the level of use. At their Dec 6 meeting, the Healdsburg City Council recommended that policies under the Ongoing Parklet Program include criteria to increase activation of downtown parklets.

**We need to see a MAJOR level of improvement and standards as far as aesthetics (the one at Pizzando looks like a shanty homeless tent encampment).**

Parklet guidelines under the extended parklet program do not permit temporary tenting. Pizzando has applied for a Temporary Parklet Permit extension and must remove their tenting by Dec 31st or upon approval of their new permit, whichever comes first.

What is the new rationale in extending this now that there is NO limitation on indoor capacity at any establishment?

In short, the temporary parklet permit extension is intended to outlive the current emergency order as businesses recoup from losses incurred during the pandemic. Additionally, should health orders change for the worse, businesses have available outdoor space to continue providing onsite service. I would encourage you to visit our [outreach page](#) as it has taken months of community outreach and direction from City Council to get us to where we are now with the parklets.

Who is the City Council person in charge of this program?

Parklet program management is done in collaboration with the Community Services, Public Works, Police, Fire, Utilities, Planning, and Building Departments. City Council as a whole provides direction to City staff on the program duration and policies.

Dear Mr. Zimmer and Members of the Healdsburg City Council,

As I will be unable to make the April 7th meeting I appreciate the opportunity to share some thoughts around the ongoing Parklet Program.

While entirely supportive of the program when it was initiated as a necessary response to helping businesses grapple with the financial burdens we experienced in respond to Covid, the parklet program has since taken on a life of its own that has fundamentally changed the way the downtown is perceived and, I would argue, experienced. Driving down Healdsburg Avenue today, where one used to see a mix of unique architectural styles and storefront displays the view is now one of uninspiring wooden structures, many of the screened, obscuring both the architecture and the vitality of the businesses behind them. Only sporadically occupied in good weather, for most of the year they are empty shells, especially depressing in winter.

They have also acerbated the longstanding problem Healdsburg has with a lack of adequate parking in the downtown. My frustration with how the City has (not) dealt with this issue, which affects stakeholders, residents, and visitors alike, comes from both my tenure on the Planning Commission where I saw multiple costly parking

studies never acted upon, and from experiencing the decline of customers from nearby towns and cities who no longer come to Healdsburg to shop and dine because “it’s not worth the effort trying to park.” 40 spaces have been lost to parklets. No alternative parking options outside the downtown with clear signage that might help mitigate congestion of cars circling the Plaza in search of parking has ever, to my knowledge, even been considered.

Originally intended to help restaurants comply with safe distance dining, parklets now include retail and tasting rooms. While they may serve some retail businesses, has a study been done whether the parklets have in fact helped the bottom line of the majority of businesses who felt compelled to commit to the ongoing costs of constructing and maintaining them year round?

By all means lets see existing parklets kept in good repair-many are not - and ensure they are safe...but the larger question we should be asking is whether it is time for a broader discussion about the long term benefits to continuing - much less expanding- the program. We all love how dining spills out of restaurants toward the street in many foreign countries but what has worked for centuries so successfully elsewhere is not what we have created in Healdsburg. Whether from a car or strolling, the city’s objective should be a visual invitation to participate in our unique food, wine and mercantile culture, not filling the public sphere with poorly designed parklets that impede flow, limit visual access, and have in fact reduced the number of parking spaces in an already congested part of our beautiful downtown.

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Hello Healdsburg City Council members, and Public Works,

Wanted to drop a quick line to say that I think it's time to take a break from the downtown parklets, and get rid of them. While there may be a few of these spaces that get more use, I think that the majority of the parklets are underutilized spaces at this point - particularly in the cool and wet months. I have also noticed parklets that remain after a business leaves which seems unnecessary. It should have been a requirement that the parklet be removed if the business that installed it leaves.

I find that some days I don't shop in the downtown shops or grab a coffee or bite at the bakery because there isn't anywhere to quickly park in the vicinity - even a few blocks away. The parklets are partly responsible for the additional congestion since they have taken parking spaces out of use. I am happy to walk, and do walk downtown whenever I can, but I don't always have the time to walk from home. In addition to removing parklets I think it might be helpful to consider adding a few more short term parking spaces (ie 30 minutes) to encourage more turn over for quick shopping downtown.

Dear Mayor Mitchel - good morning, I would like to present this news coverage from earlier in the year of a crash in San Francisco that occurred knocking out a parklet and injuring 6 people. I would like everyone to remember that downtown is not a walking downtown park area but a downtown that has vehicular access to every street in the downtown area. All these streets are used by cars carrying locals and tourists, but also the delivery trucks and garbage trucks that bring in our supplies and take away our waste. These are larger vehicles than a Subaru and at some point there will be an accident and plywood walls up with 4 x 4 post is not going to be the same barrier that a physical wall of a building will provide protection for the general public. I think long-term one has to consider the liability that this policy exposes the city too.

Also, as I know, sewage and water rates were raised last year. Is there adequate sewer and water capacity at each of the seven restaurant parklets with the addition of the new tables for dining? Are these 7 restaurant locations in compliance regarding the flow of water utilities for the number of seats they now have and are they in compliance with the required number of bath rooms for these new seats?

The parklet program was great to help small business when Covid hit, but I would like us to return to the old days and reopen this playbook when the next pandemic hits.

Dear Public Works team

I am writing to express my views regarding the Parklet policy. Around the plaza we need to keep 100% parking for tourists and patrons of the many businesses and restaurants there. I suggest two one slot loading zone yellow area for pick up and drop off of seniors or handicapped persons. I also suggest more Parking signage about the large parking lot between North and Matheson on the plaza to direct vehicles there.

On nearby side streets the same should be true. On Plaza between Center and East, one entire side of parking is subsumed by three Parklets- winery, Mexican restaurant and wine shop/ wine tasting. This is too much! The only one that really “needs it” is the Mexican restaurant which is large inside. The other wine parklets sit empty 95% of the time but have reduced critical parking spots on Plaza.

The city parking lot at East and Plaza needs upgrading in terms of the asphalt. There is plenty of parking for seniors.

Hello Healdsburg City Council members, and Public Works,

Wanted to drop a quick line to say that I think it's time to take a break from the downtown parklets, and get rid of them. While there may be a few of these spaces that get more use, I think that the majority of the parklets are underutilized spaces at this point - particularly in the cool and wet months. I have also noticed parklets that remain after a business leaves which seems unnecessary. It should have been a requirement that the parklet be removed if the business that installed it leaves.

I find that some days I don't shop in the downtown shops or grab a coffee or bite at the bakery because there isn't anywhere to quickly park in the vicinity - even a few blocks away. The parklets are partly responsible for the additional congestion since they have taken parking spaces out of use. I am happy to walk, and do walk downtown whenever I can, but I don't always have the time to walk from home. In addition to removing parklets I think it might be helpful to consider adding a few more short term parking spaces (ie 30 minutes) to encourage more turn over for quick shopping downtown.

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Hello, I'm emailing to weigh in on the parklets discussion.

I moved to Healdsburg in 1988, and soon joined what was then called the Economic Development Coalition. In addition to city/chamber discussions about the local business environment, a regular lament was "how do we expand the social and economic impact and success of the Plaza?" At that time, Plaza businesses were more diverse, with a stockbroker, a travel agent, office supplies and other local-serving businesses, but it was clear that the transformation had begun, and the vision of the 1982 R/UDAT report was coming toward us.

Businesses right around the Plaza seemed to be more successful than those even a block away, and catalyst projects like Hotel Healdsburg accelerated the transformation. In the intervening years, the "Plaza Effect" has migrated out a bit, especially north south along Center Street and Healdsburg Avenue, but "being on the Plaza" is still the goal of many businesses.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, the City (and other municipalities) began to experiment with parklets. An act born of desperation and creativity accomplished what we all dreamed about back in the 1980s and 1990s. Parklets have essentially expanded the "Plaza Effect" – right there on the Plaza and on adjacent blocks. Now that businesses have access to both indoor and outdoor dining and display space, they can serve more customers, be successful, pay taxes and fess, and add energy and vitality to the downtown environment. We can't add more buildings to the Plaza, but you can (and did) add more energy and capacity.

It would be a shame if you outlawed parklets or made them too difficult or costly to utilize. The downtown area would go back to focusing on cars, with interesting shops and sidewalks surrounding a nice park, rather than an innovative and successful blended space, that favors pedestrians and invites people to linger.

I'm aware that some folks aren't happy if they see a parking space filled with people instead on cars, but I remind you that from the 1982 R/UDAT through now, every study, every plan, every vision is for a friendly and walkable downtown. Please don't back away from that achievement.

While we're on the topic of parking, I appreciate the 5-minute and 15-minute zones downtown. They're perfect for a coffee, bakery, ice cream, or taco pickup, and it's nice to see them turning over.

Lastly (also about parking), we've had a foot surgery, a knee surgery and a hip surgery in my house over the last decade, and being able to use a temporary disabled parking placard allowed us to participate in downtown activities. Given the trend of aging Healdsburgers, perhaps you can ask

Public Works to identify a few more accessible spaces downtown; the ones I see are rarely open, illustrating demand.

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## Public Comment: Equity in Curb Space – Why Parklets Shouldn't Be Replaced by Free Parking

Dear Councilmembers,

If the City of Healdsburg moves to ban parklets in favor of returning space to free public parking, I respectfully urge you to consider the equity and economics of how our curb space is allocated.

Currently, parklets—dynamic spaces that bring life, business, and community to our downtown—are either directly paid for by businesses or supported by city investment. Meanwhile, adjacent curbside parking remains free, even though it occupies the same high-demand public real estate. This means we are effectively subsidizing car storage while charging rent for community space.

### Free Parking Isn't Free

As urban planning expert Donald Shoup explains in *The High Cost of Free Parking*, free parking distorts the value of land and encourages unnecessary driving, congestion, and pollution. Cities across the country are recognizing this and moving toward demand-based paid parking to:

- Improve parking turnover
- Reduce traffic congestion and circling
- Fund transportation and infrastructure improvements

### Case Study: SFpark

San Francisco implemented SFpark, a demand-responsive pricing system. The results were measurable and significant:

- A 30% increase in parking availability
- Reduced vehicle miles traveled
- Enhanced business performance near priced spaces

### Healdsburg's Own Numbers Tell the Story

At \$1.63 per square foot, a standard parking space downtown (ranging from 144 to 198 square feet) would be valued at \$235 to \$323 per month—exactly what many businesses are now paying for parklet spaces.

To match that cost, free parking would need to be replaced with metered rates in the range of:

- \$8–\$11 per day, or
- \$1.00–\$1.50 per hour, assuming 10 hours of paid parking each day

#### A Better Policy: Paid Parking is Fair Parking

If parklets are removed, the space they leave behind should not be given away. It should be priced fairly, based on demand, just as we do with any valuable public asset.

Revenue from paid parking could be reinvested in:

- Downtown beautification
- Transit and bike infrastructure
- A small business grant program or future parklet improvements

Let's make sure Healdsburg's curb space policy reflects our values—equity, community, and fiscal responsibility.



In February, 2022 City Council decided to make the parklet program an ongoing program. The program is planned to be reviewed again in 2025. There are new guidelines and fees associated with the program.

Matt, See below;

1) Their current permit (issued at the start of the pandemic) is expiring Dec 31st and had loose aesthetic requirements due to the rush to help businesses stay afloat at a time when there were no indoor operations for restaurants/tasting rooms.

**Yes, I clearly understand that - along with everyone else on earth that WAS the reason - to state this is insulting and unnecessary.**

My intention was not to insult but to help explain why parklets have a varying level of aesthetic requirements. Two parklet programs are running simultaneously until the end of this month, and an ongoing program is in development, so it can get confusing. I am glad you understand.

2) Both businesses have applied for a temporary extension, and we are verifying their compliance under stricter guidelines as approved by City Council.

**Please send me those stricter guidelines. WHO is enforcing these new guidelines - what is are the specific name(s) of these enforcers?**

The current guidelines can be downloaded from our [website](#), where you

can find information on enforcement, inspections, and violations.

3) Businesses are not required to keep tables/chairs in their parklets when not operating, and many secure them indoors.

**These two businesses have never ever had a table, a chair, or even a customer in the roped off area. It has never ever been used. Both businesses are operated only during the day so this is very easy to monitor. Again if they are not going to use the space you are taking away PUBLIC space that the rest of us PAY for.**

I appreciate your observations and opinion. Thank you.

4) While there is no specific requirement for providing a measurable level of use under the temporary programs, this requirement will be worked into any ongoing parklet program that would outlive the pandemic / temporary parklet programs.

**What? Either there is or there is not. Are you saying there was NOT a "measurable level of use" prior but now there will be? Please point to me where that is spelled out in the new guidelines approved by the City Council.**

Under our current parklet guidelines, there is no specific requirement regarding the level of use. At their Dec 6 meeting, the Healdsburg City Council recommended that policies under the Ongoing Parklet Program include criteria to increase activation of downtown parklets.

**We need to see a MAJOR level of improvement and standards as far as aesthetics (the one at Pizzando looks like a shanty homeless tent encampment).**

Parklet guidelines under the extended parklet program do not permit temporary tenting. Pizzando has applied for a Temporary Parklet Permit extension and must remove their tenting by Dec 31st or upon approval of their new permit, whichever comes first.

**What is the new rationale in extending this now that there is NO limitation on indoor capacity at any establishment?**

In short, the temporary parklet permit extension is intended to outlive the current emergency order as businesses recoup from losses incurred during the pandemic. Additionally, should health orders change for the worse, businesses have available outdoor space to continue providing

onsite service. I would encourage you to visit our [outreach page](#) as it has taken months of community outreach and direction from City Council to get us to where we are now with the parklets.

**Who is the City Council person in charge of this program?**

Parklet program management is done in collaboration with the Community Services, Public Works, Police, Fire, Utilities, Planning, and Building Departments. City Council as a whole provides direction to City staff on the program duration and policies.

We occasionally send out e-blasts regarding upcoming engagement sessions and program updates as they occur. Please let me know if you would like me to add your e-mail the list.



Dear City Officials,

The parklet program launched in January 2023 by the City of Healdsburg has been a beacon of vibrancy in the city's core that has visibly increased foot traffic, created microclimates of palpable energy around businesses that have spread to surrounding areas, and has increased space for residents and visitors alike to enjoy our city's businesses. Our city anecdotally feels more alive and empirically there have been tangible monetary benefits to the city and local businesses. I am happy to lend my ardent support for this program and encourage you to authorize its continuation and its expansion.

There will be voices of opposition that will coalesce around one common negative talking point: that parklets remove needed parking spaces. If we apply rational and critical thinking to this talking point it is quickly rendered to be moot. 1/ As of 2018 there are 530 parking spaces in designated parking lots all within a standard two city block radius of the plaza. These lots are in addition to the parking spaces on the streets surrounding the plaza within the same radius. 2/ Parklets have removed approximately 40 spaces from available street parking with all of them being directly in front of businesses utilizing the parklet. Walking half a city block opens anyone to a street where that number of available spaces is not only available but typically unoccupied except on the busiest of days in the city. And 3/ commuters who use their own vehicle walk an average of 164 steps to enter a retail store from a parking lot in towns surrounding us where there are big box retailers—this is approximately 0.1 miles or 528 feet. The distance from the plaza to any of the city's parking lots is less than 600 feet—with two large lots being within 250 feet. Any argument that our city lacks available parking should be met with the highest amount of skepticism and debate that uses factual and empirical evidence—as I have posited here. There will be those who lack the faculty to accept the

factual evidence—it is imperative that you do not give way to emotional or irrational fear, uncertainty, and doubt with regards to parklets.

Put simply: parklets have not removed needed parking spaces.

I strongly urge you to lend your continued support to this program and to expand it.
